

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
December 16, 2014

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, December 16, 2014. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 and all council members were present except Councilperson Harrington.

The minutes of December 2, 2014 were reviewed and accepted as written.

PAZ Chairman, Wayne Jones reviewed a sub-division whose entrance will cross over an ISV parcel. He explained that the county wanted ISV to be aware of this prior to approval. Jones explained that the Town Engineer will need to approve the entrance sign and he feels no other action is required.

Sheriff Chris Curry and his wife Pam were in attendance. Mayor Bell-Guercio read a proclamation from Indian Springs Village proclaiming Sheriff Curry an honorary citizen of ISV. A framed copy of the proclamation was presented to Sheriff Curry by the Mayor. ISV t-shirts, provided by the ISV Garden Club, were also presented to Sheriff Curry and his wife, Pam. Robins thanked Sheriff Curry for his many years of service and friendship to ISV.

Councilman Stauss informed the council that the domain name [indianspringsvillage.info](http://indianspringsvillage.info) is about to expire and recommended it not be renewed. The council agreed.

In light of the potential development of a hotel and conference center in Oak Mountain State Park, Bell-Guercio read a resolution concerning the protection and preservation of the ecological and environmental integrity of Oak Mountain State Park. Councilman Mendel made a motion that Resolution 12-16-14-01 be adopted. Stauss seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous. Bell-Guercio informed the council that a group of concerned citizens are forming a coalition called Keep Oak Mountain

Wild. Their goal is similar to the resolution passed. She will keep the council apprised of their progress.

Mayor Bell Guercio wished everyone a happy holiday season and invited everyone to join in the annual holiday celebration. She adjourned the meeting at 7:15 p.m.
