Dear Citizens' Environmental Advisory Committee,

This is a follow up letter per our discussion at the December 29, 2016 meeting. North Shelby Fire District (NSFD) has limited abilities to control large hazardous materials incidents, but we do have the capabilities to control most smaller incidents. As for mitigating a hazardous incident concerning storm water management, NSFD carries a limited number of hydrocarbon absorbent booms along with absorbent pads. If we were to have an incident located in Indian Springs Village, we would respond to the incident and begin mitigating the incident while evaluating the need for further assistance. The Shelby County Emergency Management Agency will be notified, and the City of Hoover Fire Department's hazardous materials response unit would be notified if the situation dictates. If needed, due to a very large incident, the City of Pelham Fire Department's hazardous response unit would also be requested. NSFD has mutual aid agreements with the City of Hoover and the City of Pelham for such incidents.
