

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
April 6, 2019

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, April 6, 2019. Mayor Brenda Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Boy Scout, Jackson Lyle of Troop #538 led in the Pledge of Allegiance. All councilmembers were present except Councilmembers Ed Whatley and Brian Stauss.

The minutes from April 2, 2019 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember McClurkin seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Fire Chief Buddy Tyler reported new landscaping at Station #3.

Wayne Jones, Chairman ISV Planning and Zoning, reported that he and the city engineer are working on the details of a new sub-division in conjunction with the architect for Bent Tree Acres. It is not ready to go to the PAZ at this time.

Bell-Guercio introduced Katie Bailey from the North Shelby Library. She gave an overview of the summer reading program and asked for our continued support. Bell-Guercio asked for a motion to submit a \$2500 grant to the North Shelby Library. Robins so moved and Elliott seconded. The vote was unanimous. Bailey thanked the Council for their generosity.

Robins reported that he has been in touch with George Williams of Precision Home Crafters, and they are currently working on their proposal for the Town Hall renovation project.

Elliott reported that most all of the street signs have been installed. However, we missed the Caldwell Mill and Cahaba Valley Road sign. He has been in touch with Signarama and they will place an order for this sign.
