

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

April 18, 2023

7:00 p.m.

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, April 18, 2023. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The Clerk called the roll and everyone was present except Councilmembers Whatley and Elliott

There were no minutes of April 4, 2023 meeting to review due to no quorum for that meeting, however the minutes of the March 21, 2023 were reviewed. Councilmember McClurkin made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember Robins seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Wayne Jones, Chairman of the Planning and Zoning Commission, presented an application for subdivision by Eleanor Bennett, 2620 Cahaba Valley Road, Indian Springs AL. 35124. The purpose of the subdivision is to turn a single parcel of land into two separate lots for Single Family Use only. The application had been presented and approved at the Planning and Zoning Board meeting, April 11, 2023. After discussion, Councilmember Harley made a motion to accept the Bennett Subdivision as presented, Councilmember McClurkin seconded and all were in agreement.

Councilmember Harley presented the March 2023 financials. After discussion, Harley made a motion to approve financials as presented. Councilmember Robins seconded and the vote was unanimous to accept the March 2023 financials.

Kate Etheredge, North Shelby County Library Director and Vanessa Warner, Youth Services Librarian were present to discuss the Summer Reading Program at the North Shelby County Library. It was discussed that Indian Springs Village would again sponsor the Summer Reading Program with the same grant amount of \$2500.00. Harley made a motion to award a grant of \$2500.00 to the North Shelby County Library, seconded by McClurkin with all in favor.

Shane McCombs, the new Head Football Coach for Oak Mountain High School was present to introduce himself and express how he was happy to be a part of the community.

Bell-Guercio asked for a motion to re-appoint Jack Mendel and Bruce Monical to the Zoning Board of Adjustments (ZBA), terms of both will terminate February 26, 2026. Harley made a motion to accept the appointments and McClurkin seconded. The vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio also asked for a motion to re-appoint Wayne Jones to the Planning and Zoning Commission for a term of six years that will start February 26, 2023. Harley made a motion to accept the re-appointment and McClurkin seconded. The vote was unanimous

There being no further business, Mayor Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:40 p.m.
