

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
April 20, 2021

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, April 20, 2021. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All Councilmembers were present.

The minutes of April 6th, 2021 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio reported that ADEM has not extended the burn dates, therefore, April 30th is the last day to burn debris.

Harley presented the March financials. After a brief discussion he made a motion to accept the financials as presented. Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Robins updated the Council with regard to the progress of tornado wood debris pickup. He stated that the trucks were back to Indian Trail area making a second pass. It was determined that no more debris can be put on the road for pickup after this pass is completed on the Indian Trail area. All means of communication will be used to put this out to the citizenry. The trucks are still on the first pass on the Double Oak Lane area. The trucks will leave as soon as all pickup is made, but for sure by April 30th per their contract.

Robins informed the Council that the new street signs will be delivered tomorrow. Installation may be slow to start due to tornado.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:45 pm.
