

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
April 21, 2020

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, April 21, 2020. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. All Council members were present except Councilmember Mary Sue McClurkin.

The minutes of March 3, 17 and April 7, 2020 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Ed Whatley presented the February and March financials. After brief discussion, Elliott made a motion to accept financials as presented. Robins seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio presented Ordinance No. 2020-001 which provides for an emergency response to the Covid-19 outbreak. Elliott made a motion to accept the Ordinance as presented and Harley seconded. The vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio also presented Ordinance No. 2020-002 which is an ordinance to adopt regulations for small cell technology facilities in the Town of Indian Springs Village. After a brief discussion, Whatley made a motion to accept the ordinance as presented. Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio also presented the quote from North Shelby Fire Chief Buddy Tyler. Chief Tyler recommended the Town add nine new fire hydrants at \$5000 each. After discussion, Elliott made a motion to suspend the rules and vote on the expenditure, Whatley seconded and the vote was unanimous. A roll call vote was held and the results are as follows:

Harley made a motion to accept the proposal for nine new fire hydrants for a total of approximately \$45,000. Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Robins reported due to the Covid-19 there will be a delay in the maintenance of the entrance signs.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:45 pm.
