

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
December 1, 2020

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, December 1, 2020. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All Councilmembers were present.

The minutes of November 17, 2020 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Wayne Jones reported that the ZBA will be holding a meeting to December 10th at 7:00 in the Multipurpose building to consider a request for a special exception from Midland Valleydale LLC. The special exception would be to allow a drive through for Starbucks Coffee Shop. The Starbucks will be built in the parking lot of the WalMart Neighborhood Grocery.

The Council discussed that due to the spike in Covid-19 all facility rentals will be cancelled until further notice.

Robins reported on his work on ISV street sign pricing. After discussion he will continue to find a company and pricing that can do the work.

Bell-Guercio presented two quotes for hardwood floors. Harley made a motion to accept the bid from Hill's Carpet & Floor Coverings. Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:50 pm.
