

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

December 6, 2022

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, December 6, 2022. Chairman Pro Tem Robins called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The Clerk called the roll and Mayor Bell-Guercio was not in attendance.

Minutes of November 15, 2022 meeting were reviewed. Councilmember Harley made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Scott Chandler and Dannon Appleyard were present from OX Foundation Solutions to discuss the proposed crawlspace encapsulation project for Town Hall. After discussion, the Council decided to move forward with the project. It was put to a vote as follows:
