TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
February 21, 2023

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, February 21, 2023. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The Clerk called the roll and everyone was present except Councilmember Dale Elliott.

Minutes of February 7, 2023 meeting were reviewed. Councilmember Robins made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.
