TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
February 4, 2020

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, February 4, 2020. Mayor Brenda Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. After the Pledge of Allegiance, the Town Clerk called the roll and all Councilmembers were present.

The Council meeting minutes of January 21, 2020 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Robins reported an additional handrail was placed on the kitchen porch. Additionally, he introduced Don Jones who presented a plan for phase two landscaping for the Town Hall along with a new stone mailbox. Jones will get pricing on the plans and report back to the Council.

Councilmember Elliott reported that February is Heart Month. A CPR class will be held at the next Kiwanis meeting. The meeting will be held at OMHS in the media room on Thursday, February 20th at 6:30 pm.

Bell-Guercio asked for a motion to re-appoint Jack Mendel to the Zoning Board of Adjustment (ZBA) for a term of three years that will terminate on February 26, 2023. Elliott made a motion to accept the appointment, Robins seconded and the vote was unanimous. Bell-Guercio asked for a motion to re-appoint Bruce Monical to the ZBA whose term will terminate February 26, 2023. Robins made a motion to accept the appointment and Whatley seconded. The vote was unanimous. Bell-Guercio also asked for a motion to re-appoint Russell Schenk to the Planning and Zoning Commission for a term of six years that will terminate February 26, 2026. Whatley made a motion to accept the re-appointment and Robins seconded. The vote was unanimous.

Jake Guercio, President of ISV Kiwanis, reminded everyone of the Kiwanis Pancake breakfast February 29th at the Oak Mountain Middle School from 7:00 – 11:00 pm. The proceeds will help with the play ground project for the OMMS. He asked everyone to make plans to attend.
