

**INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
February 7, 2023**

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, February 7, 2023. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The Clerk called the roll and everyone was present except Councilmember Dale Elliott.

Minutes of January 17, 2023 meeting were reviewed. Councilmember Harley made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember Robins seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Lt. Brandon Miller was present from the North Shelby Fire Department. A concern had been received by the Council about parking on Timber Hill Road during school hours. Miller stated there was not a problem getting fire and emergency vehicles through but would address it with the school should there become a need.

Councilmember Harley went over 2022/2023 grants from Indian Springs Village. To date, Indian Springs Village has awarded \$819,259 through the 2% sales tax. Approximately 85% went directly to the 4 schools, in addition to \$50,000 for Oak Mountain High School turf and track renovations at Herdmont and other smaller amounts to various recipients including North Shelby Library for their Summer Reading Program. Everyone was in agreement that the grants funding several projects had been well spent.

Resolution No. 02-07-2023-01 extending the Moratorium on certain new businesses (Resolution No. 10-14-2022-002) was presented for approval. After discussion, Councilmember Whatley made a motion to approve the resolution and McClurkin seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

Scout Grayson Norman with Troop 71 was present to fulfill requirements for his Communication Badge.

There being no further business, Mayor Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:30 p.m.
