

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
January 17, 2023

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, January 17, 2023. Chairman Pro Tem Robins called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The Clerk called the roll and Mayor Bell-Guercio was not in attendance.

Minutes of January 3, 2023 meeting were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Harley presented the financials for December 2022. Councilmember Harley made a motion to accept the financial report as presented and councilmember Elliott seconded. The vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Harley presented a request from Oak Mountain Middle School for \$7,000 for removal of the old bleachers. The quote from the company that was going to install the new bleachers did not include removal of the old ones. It was put to a vote as follows:

Robins asked for a motion to suspend the rules for immediate consideration to move forward with the request from Oak Mountain Middle School for \$7,000 to remove the old bleachers. Elliott made a motion to suspend the rules, Harley seconded, and the roll call vote was as follows:

Whatley made a motion to approve the \$7,000 grant to Oak Mountain Middle School, and McClurkin seconded. The roll call vote was as follows:

All in favor, no opposed, the motion was approved.

Council Member Harley presented another request from Oak Mountain Middle School for the purchase of new floor buffer/cleaner. It was estimated that a new floor cleaner would cost around \$10,000. Attempts were made to find someone who could repair the floor cleaner, however it seems that it is too old for repair. After a discussion, it was decided that this request would be tabled.

There being no further business, Robins adjourned the meeting at 7:30 p.m.
