

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

January 19, 2016

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, January 19, 2016. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Boy Scout, David Lether led the Pledge of Allegiance. The Town Clerk called the roll and all council members were present.

The minutes of January 5, 2016 were reviewed and accepted as written.

Councilman Mendel presented the Financial Report for December 31, 2015. Mendel moved to endorse the report and Councilman Trammell seconded. The vote was unanimous.

Frazier Christy, Town Engineer was in attendance and answered additional questions concerning the proposed Storm Water Management Plan which is required for the Town's pending Phase II MS4 permit (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System). The Phase II permit is required by ADEM (Alabama Department of Environmental Management) for all storm water discharges from small municipalities in an effort to protect water quality by reducing the discharge of pollutants in storm water. Discussion and questions concerning the proposed Erosion Control and Sedimentation Ordinance was directed to Mr. Christy. Mr. Christy noted that all corrections had been made to the document and was ready to be posted and the public hearing will be February 16th.

Bell-Guercio informed the Council that John Strozier and Ralph Bodie agreed to be reappointed to the Zoning Board of Adjustment effective February 26, 2016 for a three year term. Alison Stiger also agreed to be reappointed to the Planning and Zoning Committee effective February 26, 2016 for a six year term. Robins made a motion to accept these appointments and Mendel seconded. The vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio presented a letter written to a resident for the purpose of cleaning up the property. The Council agreed the letter should be sent.

Purchasing and installing Christmas decorations to the telephone poles in ISV were discussed as a possibility for next year. Additional, investigation needs to be done and will be reviewed at another meeting.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 8:15 P.M.
