

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
January 19, 2021

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, January 19, 2021. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All Councilmembers were present except Councilmember Ed Whatley.

The minutes of January 5, 2021 were reviewed. Councilmember Harley made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Robins reported the street light at Caldwell Mill and Hwy. 119 has been repaired. The county put up the High Gate Hill street sign that was missing. The speed limit and children at play signs are being up in Cahaba Oaks.

Elliott reported on the progress of covid-19 vaccinations in Shelby County. Right now, the problem is not enough vaccine available.

Bell-Guercio reported that she, Rich Harley and Joan Downs met with town attorney, Ben Goldman concerning the proposed 2% ISV sales and use tax. Mr. Goldman explained and provided a memorandum as a guideline as to how to proceed with this process. Mr. Goldman will produce an ordinance, resolution and any other documents needed to adopt these taxes. Also, Mr. Goldman was directed to add some corrective language to our business license ordinance. Additionally, he is working on the equipment lease and waiver for the fire department for the equipment the town purchased.

The Shelby Mart is no longer operational, therefore a new posting place must be adopted. The OMES has given permission to post Town notices and other required postings at the school. Harley made a motion to change posting place to OMES. Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio informed the council that Nelda Kelly is rolling off the PAZ commission and asked for a motion to re-appoint her as a PAZ member. Elliott made a motion to re-appoint Nelda Kelly to the PAZ commission. Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:35 pm.
