

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
January 3, 2019

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, January 3, 2019. Mayor Brenda Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All councilmembers were present except Mary Sue McClurkin.

The minutes from December 4th and December 18th were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept both sets of minutes as presented. Councilmember Whatley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Robins updated the Council on his discussion with Contractors for drive-way apron paving. He will continue to update when quotes are received. Robins also read the letter of notification from Amy Easton, the ISV cleaning service that she will be ending her contract with ISV effective February 1, 2019, due to increased family and church obligations. She thanked them for the opportunity to serve the Town. Robins noted Amy's dedicated volunteer work for ISV in decorating the Town Hall, but also her efforts on the interior design of the new building and procuring appliances. She will be greatly missed.

Considerable discussion was had with regard to ISV street signs. Elliott will take on the project of replacing timeworn ISV street signs. He will get pricing from vendors and coordinate with the county and state for approval.

Mayor Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:45 pm.
