The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, January 4, 2022. Mayor Brenda Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All councilmembers were present except Councilmember Mary Sue McClurkin.
