

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
January 7, 2020

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, January 7, 2019. Mayor Brenda Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All councilmembers were present except Councilmember Elliott.

The Council meeting minutes of December 17, 2019 were reviewed. Councilmember McClurkin made a motion to accept minutes as presented with the exception of Herb Robins was not in attendance at the December 17<sup>th</sup> meeting. Councilmember Robins seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Fire Chief Tyler reported that pre-incident planning was on-going. The new Battalion Chief 2020 Tahoe has been received. The fire department has maps and will be working on locating all fire hydrants on the maps. This will help provide data as to where new hydrants may be needed.

Robins reported that Town Engineer, Frazier Christy passed away recently from his final battle with cancer. Frazier courageously fought and won several battles with different types of cancer over the years while continuing to serve ISV. He was introduced as the new town Engineer by Mayor Steve Zerkis in February 2005 and served us well for the next 15 years. Frazier was instrumental in drafting or updating almost all of the current ISV ordinances and regulations including the zoning ordinance, sub-division regulations, erosion and sedimentation control, flood damage control, business licenses, fee schedules, building permit requirements, development analysis and mitigation plan along with MS-4 permit compliance. He was also instrumental in getting the state and county to improve the safety of the dams at Oak Mountain State Park. Frazier was a great friend to the Town and will be greatly missed.

Councilmember Whatley presented the November financials. Whatley made a motion to accept the financials as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio reported she will be meeting tomorrow with Jerry Short who has been filling in as Town Engineer since the passing of Mr. Christy. She will report back at the next council meeting. She also discussed a new mailbox for the Town Hall. Additional landscape will be needed and a plan will be designed.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:20 p.m.
