

2019 INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
July 17, 2018

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, July 17, 2018. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. All Councilmembers were present.

Minutes from June 19th were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented and Councilmember Whatley seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the minutes stand approved. Minutes from July 3, 2018 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented and Councilmember Stauss seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the minutes stand approved.

Whatley presented the June 2018 financials. The financials were discussed and Whatley made a motion to accept the financials as presented. Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous. The June financials stand approved. The 2019 budget planning will begin in August. The proposed budget will be discussed at the first meeting in September and voted on the second meeting in September.

The Town Clerk presented a report identifying excess property to the Council which included a HP Laserjet 3015 all-in-one printer. Whatley made a motion to dispose of the equipment by placing it into the dumpster. Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.

The Town Hall porches are in very bad condition. The bid used for the grant applied for last year is being updated. Whatley will procure two additional bids for this project in order to begin this project.

The entrance sign at OMMS was damaged and needs to be repaired. Additionally, the ISV street signs are in very poor condition. Investigation on replacing signs that must be in compliance with federal mandates will begin.

The ISV Comprehensive Plan was reviewed. The acknowledgement page was discussed. Corrections will be made and a public hearing will be called for the August 21st council meeting.

Bell-Guercio shared some insight into window security as needed by the four Oak Mountain schools. Additional cost and needs are being assessed and she asked the council think about assisting with the cost. More information will follow.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 8:00 pm.
