

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
June 1, 2021

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, June 1, 2021. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All Councilmembers were present.

The minutes of May 18, 2021 were reviewed. Councilmember McClurkin made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Wayne Jones, Chairman Planning and Zoning reported that ISV has a new sub-division request from Eleanor Bennett. He is working to get a corrected plat plan prior to calling a PAZ meeting.

Councilmember Robins reported that installation of phase 1 of street signs is complete. The additional signs and hardware have been ordered. We are still under \$35K on signs and under \$30K for installation which was original approved amounts.

Bell-Guercio reported that the American Flags did not go out prior to Memorial Day due to lack of someone to install them. After discussion, Wayne Jones is going to look into finding someone to install flags before the 4<sup>th</sup> of July.

Bell-Guercio also brought to the table the need for a facilities manager and perhaps a cleaning service to clean up after all events. She will be looking into the cleaning services and cost and procuring a handy man that can help with general maintenance needs.

Bell-Guercio also stated a review and update of ISV facility rules are needed. Several ideas were discussed. She will work on the updates discussed and will present to Council at the next meeting for approval.

Bell-Guercio also noted that Rick Harley is looking into the possibility of a new reservation system for facility rentals. He will report back to the Council.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 8:00 pm.
