

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE

TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

June 15, 2021

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, June 15, 2021. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All Council members were present except Councilmember Ed Whatley.

The minutes of June 1, 2021 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Harley presented the May financials. After a brief discussion, he made a motion to accept the May financials as presented. Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Robins reported that the additional road signage has been received and is scheduled to be installed tomorrow and this should complete the project. Due to the theft of the new Auburn Road sign, Robins proposed to reinstitute a previous ISV policy of offering a \$1000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of anyone stealing or vandalizing municipal property. He will prepare and submit for approval specific language at the next council meeting.

Robins also presented a scope of work for a proposed ISV facilities manager. Some changes need to be made and will be presented at the next council meeting.

Harley was not able to get in touch with our web-site facilitator with regard to the reservation software system. He will continue to reach out to him.

Bell-Guercio went over the changes to the facility rules. After discussion she said she would update the changes and bring back to the Council for approval.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:55 pm.
