

**INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
June 16, 2020**

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, June 16, 2020. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Boy Scouts Scott and C.J. Taylor of Troop 533 led the Pledge of Allegiance. Boy Scouts were in attendance to earn their communication badge. All Council members were present except Councilmember Mary Sue McClurkin.

The minutes of June 2, 2020 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Chief Buddy Tyler reported 7 of the 8 new fire hydrants have been installed. The new pumper will arrive in Pelham on Wednesday. Randy Sipe will be the new Fire Chief, effective November 1, 2020.

Councilmember Robins reported the painting of the entrance signs have been completed. He thanked Don Jones for the additional light on the Town Hall sign and for planting the begonias.

Councilmember Elliott reported six new AED's need to be purchased. One to be placed in the Town Hall and one to be placed in the Multi-purpose building. Three will replace outdated ones in the Oak Mountain School System with one additional added to OMES. Elliott made a motion to suspend the rules and vote on the purchase of this equipment. Councilmember Whatley seconded. The roll call vote was as follows:

Whatley – Yay

Elliott made a motion to purchase 6 new AED's and 2 cabinets and not to exceed \$6500. Harley seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Whatley presented the May financials. After a brief discussion he made a motion to accept financials as presented. Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:15 pm.
