

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
June 18, 2019

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, June 18, 2019. Mayor Brenda Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance. All councilmembers were present except Councilmembers Ed Whatley and Brian Stauss.

The minutes from June 4th, 2019 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember McClurkin seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Wayne Jones advised the Council that the Planning and Zoning Committee unanimously approved the request to sub-divide the property on 960 Copena and the county property next to it. This will give the owner 12' of county property to use as a drive-way. The Council reviewed the plat and Elliott made a motion to accept the sub-division as presented. McClurkin seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Deputy Sheriff Pilato reported an unlawful breaking and entering of an automobile at Heardmont Park during the day. She stressed the urgency of anyone seeing suspicious vehicles to contact 9-1-1 as soon as possible. Even if it turns out not to be a problem, it is better to be safe than sorry. She needs the communities help.

Chief Buddy Tyler, NSCFD, said the department is still in the process of painting fire hydrants and has also refurbished the sign at Station #1. He invited everyone to come by and take a look.

Robins reported the outside renovation is still in progress. He also noted lead paint was found by the contractor in some areas, not unexpected in a house of this age. Proper remediation will be taken at a limited increase in cost to the project.

Bell-Guercio reported a complaint with regard to fireworks and the fire dangers and disturbance to children pets or livestock. An article will go into *The Village Voice* asking residents be good neighbors and refrain from using fireworks that could disturb their neighbors or damage property.. A Facebook post will also go out.

A quote for a storage build-out in the records room was presented and discussed. A vote will be taken at the next meeting.

Some issues with our flags were discussed. We hope to rectify these soon and have the flags displayed prior to the 4<sup>th</sup> of July.

Mayor Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:50 pm.
