TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
June 19, 2018

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, June 19, 2018. Pro Tem Robins called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. All Council members were present except for Brian Stauss and Brenda Bell-Guercio.

Minutes from June 5, 2018 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented and Councilmember Whatley seconded the motion. The minutes stand approved.

Chief Tyler reported the new fire truck will be at the Town Hall for the 4th of July celebration and it will also be showcased in Montgomery next week at a convention.

Jack Mendel, Chairman of ZBA, reported the application for the barn variance at 141 Arrowhead Lane was withdrawn. The barn was within the guidelines of the zoning ordinance therefore there was no need for a variance.

Wayne Jones, Chairman of PAZ, presented the Ramsey sub-division request as approved by PAZ. Elliott made a motion to approve as presented. Councilmember McClurkin seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Whatley presented the financials for the month ended May, 2018. He noted that ISV has met the revenue budget for the year with four months remaining and expenses are tracking on target. Whatley made a motion to approve the May financials as presented. Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.
