

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
June 2, 2020

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, June 2, 2020. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. All Council members were present.

The minutes of May 17, 2020 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Robins seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Chief Buddy Tyler reported there were 135 total calls for May, 64 fire related and 71 medical related. Low numbers for this time of year. He informed us the final inspection on the new fire engine is tomorrow. Also, the fire department is still conducting hydrant flow tests. Three of the new fire hydrants have been installed on/off Indian Crest.

Councilmember Elliott reported he and Chief Tyler will be inspecting AED's on Thursday.

Councilmember Robins reported that due to rain delays the painting company is still working on painting the entrance signs. He also reported there was a water leak outside. Davis Plumbing repaired the pipe. Furthermore, there seems to be an electrical problem with the plug inside the well house. He is going to call Shelby Electric to check out the problem. He also mentioned there are two rotted boards on the bridge and he will look into that repair.

Bell-Guercio reported that the Red Cross has asked us to support them in a local blood drive. We have told them we will post to web-site and our Facebook page. Larger surrounding areas have set a curfew due to current civil unrest. After speaking with the Sheriff and Council we will opt out of a curfew for ISV at this time.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:25 pm.
