TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
June 4, 2019

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, June 4, 2019. Mayor Brenda Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. and the Boy Scouts led in the Pledge of Allegiance. All councilmembers were present except Councilmembers Herb Robins and Brian Stauss

The minutes from May 21, 2019 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember McClurkin seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Chief Buddy Tyler, NSCFD reported in the month of May there were 159 total calls, 64 fire related and 95 medical, with a response time of 5:18 minutes. The department is in the process of painting fire hydrants.

Bell-Guercio asked the Council to think about additional lighting needed at the trash bin and in the parking area near the new building. Discussion will pursue at a later date.
