

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

June 6, 2023

7:00 p.m.

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday June 6, 2023. Chairman Pro tem Herb Robins called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The Clerk called the roll and Mayor Bell-Guercio and Councilmember Whatley were absent.

The minutes of May 16, 2023 meeting were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

The Town Council having duly posted the notices had the “first reading” of the proposed Ordinance 05-02-2023-003. Chairman Pro tem Robins stated the proposed ordinance is available at the Town Hall or each of the posted locations for anyone to read. This is an amendment to the established B-2 General Business District in Article 7 of the Zoning Ordinance for the Town of Indian Springs Village, Alabama to include Section 14 which is a Medical Overlay District which will allow tobacco shops, vape shops and CBD shops only in the Medical Overlay District as a conditional use and subject to the rules and regulations established by the proposed ordinance. Robins requested the proposed ordinance be attached to the minutes of the meeting.

The ordinance states that the Council shall set the date for Public Hearing whereby they may take action of said proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance. Chairman Pro tem Robins asked for a motion to set the Public Hearing for June 20, 2023 at the next regularly scheduled council meeting. Councilmember Elliott made a motion and Councilmember McClurkin seconded. The vote was unanimous.

Chairman Pro tem Robins went over options and cost for upgrades to our security system from Convergent. Final decision will be made at next council meeting.

Scout Tighe LaRoche of Troop 5 was in attendance for his Citizenship in the Community Badge requirement.

Chairman Pro tem Robins adjourned the meeting at 7:20 p.m.
