### **Agenda Item: Discussion on New Lighting at Oak Mountain State Park Golf Course**

Dusty Sherer, a resident of 367 Signal Trail, Indian Springs, was present at the meeting to address concerns regarding the new lighting recently installed at Oak Mountain State Park Golf Course. Mr. Sherer emphasized that the brightness of the lights was significantly impacting the surrounding neighborhood. He highlighted the adverse effects on wildlife and nature, which are integral to the residents of Indian Springs. Additionally, Mr. Sherer expressed that the lighting was causing disturbances to residents' sleep patterns, as the lights remained illuminated until 9:00 pm.

The Mayor explained that the Town of Indian Springs has no jurisdiction over Oak Mountain State Park since it is a State owned property and is located in the city of Pelham, but suggestions as to avenues to explore resolutions were discussed.
