

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
March 20, 2018

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, March 20, 2018. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. All Council members were present except Councilmember Whatley.

Minutes from March 6th were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented and Councilmember McClurkin seconded the motion. The minutes stand approved.

Fire Chief Tyler reported the new ladder truck will be here Thursday. Also, he noted delinquent fire dues notices have gone out.

Mayor Bell-Guercio introduced David Warren, who was in attendance. Mr. Warren is running for Shelby County Coroner.

Councilmember Robins reported the cost to install drip edge on the pavilion roof is \$465. Cobb Roofing is scheduled to install on Thursday.

Elliott reported the Kiwanis Fund Raiser at Heardmont Park was wet but went well.

Councilmember Stauss asked that the political sign rules be placed on Facebook and Web-site.

Mayor Bell-Guercio reported that due to additional questions and additional work needed, the Zoning Ordinance Hearing will be postponed.

A resolution to transfer ABC wine and beer license from Rite Aid to Walgreen's was presented. Elliott made a motion to accept Resolution 3-20-18-01 as presented. Stauss seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:12 pm.
