

**INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
March 21, 2023
7:00 p.m.**

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, March 21, 2023. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The Clerk called the roll and everyone was present except Councilmember Whatley and McClurkin.

There were no Minutes of March 7, 2023 meeting to review due to no quorum for that meeting, however the Minutes of the February 21, 2023 were reviewed, Councilmember Elliot made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember Robins seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Wayne Jones, Planning and Zoning Board was present to discuss the progress with the bridge being built at the Town Hall. He requested an increase to the budget that had been set for the project originally of \$10,000 to \$13,000. The council discussed the request and Mayor Bell-Guercio asked for a motion to suspend the rules for immediate consideration to move forward with the request from Wayne Jones for an additional \$3,000 to finish the Eagle Scout project of building a bridge at town hall. Harley made a motion to suspend the rules, Robins seconded, and the roll call vote was as follows:

Harley made a motion to approve the \$3,000 to Wayne Jones to finish the Eagle Scout Project of rebuilding the bridge at Town Hall, and Robins seconded. The roll call vote was as follows:

All in favor, no opposed, the motion was approved.

Wayne also discussed the sub-division of the property at 2620 Cahaba Valley Road, we are waiting on an updated plat. He remarked that since he is being copied on all of the Engineering projects, he has noticed the amount of paperwork and time spent corresponding with the Engineer has greatly increased.

Councilman Harley presented the February 2023 Financials. After discussion, Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept as presented and Councilmember Robins seconded. The vote was unanimous.

There being no further business, Mayor Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:30 p.m.
