

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
March 3, 2020

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, March 3, 2020. Mayor Brenda Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The Mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance and called the roll. All Councilmembers were present.

The Council meeting minutes of February 18, 2020 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Whatley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Robins reported on the following:

A contractor has been selected and materials ordered for the mailbox project. The project should be completed next week. Robins thanked Don Jones for his efforts on this project.

A new front porch swing has been ordered and should be delivered next week.

Thomas Contracting has completed Phase II of the Town Hall landscaping with the planting of three Shumard oaks and placing of accent boulders around the property.

Robins met with a painting contractor to repair/clean/paint five town signs at a cost of \$721.97. The Mayor called for a motion to suspend the rules and Elliott motioned, seconded by Robins.

The roll call vote results were as follows:

Elliott made a motion to accept the bid as presented seconded by Whatley. The vote was unanimous.

Robins reported that two bids had been received for Town Hall grounds maintenance beginning April 1, 2020. The Council elected to table the decision to give time to fully review the bids.
