

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
March 6, 2018

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, March 6, 2018. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and the Boy Scouts led the Pledge of Allegiance. All Council members were present except Councilmember Stauss.

Mayor Bell-Guercio had the Boy Scouts introduce themselves. Also, Bell-Guercio introduced Allison Boyd. Allison is running for Probate Judge of Shelby County.

Minutes from February 20th were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented and Councilmember Whatley seconded the motion. The minutes stand approved.

Fire Chief Tyler reported the fire department is still working on business inspections throughout the district. He also reported a three-man team will be leaving tomorrow going to Wisconsin to inspect the new ladder truck the fire district has purchased. It should be here within the next two to three weeks. Perhaps it will be ready for viewing at the annual Easter Egg Hunt on March 31st.

Wayne Jones, PAZ chairman, reported PAZ has an outstanding sub-division request (Ramsey property) they are working on.

Councilmember Robins reported that there is a water problem on the roof of the pavilion. He will meet with Cobb Roofing this week to get a quote on the repairs needed.

Elliott reported that, Bell-Guercio, Chief Tyler and himself met for the Contact 2020 meeting held last week. Contact 2020 is a task force working to combat drug addiction in our county. He also invited everyone to attend the Kiwanis meeting March 15th at the Town Hall at 7:00 PM. Also, Kiwanis is having a fund raiser at Heardmont Park, March 17th. They will be selling donuts and water to raise money for the Oak Mountain High School project.

The Town Clerk reminded everyone the annual ISV Easter Egg Hunt will be held, Saturday, March 31st, from 11-1.

Mayor Bell-Guercio reported that she has been meeting with principals and SRO's from the Oak Mountain schools with regard to safety needs of the schools and will report back after she has met with everyone.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:25 pm.
