

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
May 16, 2017

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, May 16, 2017. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, the Town Clerk called the roll and all Council members were present.

Council Meeting Minutes of April 18th, Work Session Meeting of April 18th and Council Meeting Minutes of May 2nd were reviewed and approved.

Wayne Jones, PAZ Chairperson presented the Signal Trail sub-division for Council consideration. The sub-division was approved by the Planning and Zoning Committee on May 9th, 2017. Councilmember Harrington made a motion that the Council approve the Signal Trail sub-division as presented. Councilmember Elliott seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

ZBA member, Jack Mendel reported to the Council that rules and procedures have been written by himself and Wayne Jones. A meeting will be called soon in order to approve rules and procedures and to elect officers.

Councilmember Robins reported that the new road sign and post that we purchased has been erected at Castleberry Road. He also reported that he and Mayor Bell-Guercio met with John Cooper of ALDOT to share information and open lines of communication. Robins and Bell-Guercio affirmed that ISV is not opposed to turn lanes but is definitely against widening Highway 119 to four or five lanes. Harrington suggested that the Council take action to gage the pulse of the community with regard to widening Highway 119 to four or five lanes.

Councilmember Whatley presented the April financials for the Council's review. After review, he made a motion that the Council endorse the financials as presented. Stauss seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio informed the Council that a check for \$2500 was written to the North Shelby Library for their summer reading program. Additionally, a check was written to BREMS for \$408.80 for EMS service. These amounts are in the budget therefore a motion was not required but all Council members were in agreement.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:50 pm.
