

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
May19, 2020

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, May19, 2020. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. All Council members were present.

The minutes of May 5, 2020 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Chief Buddy Tyler reported that the water main for one of the new fire hydrants that was to be located near the Lakeview Assisted Living facility is located across the street. The cost to run the hydrant across the street to the water main would not justify the benefit. He also made clear the hydrant that is located in Hoover will be sufficient. Therefore, only 8 new hydrants rather than 9 is on order.

Councilmember Whatley presented the April financials. He noted that revenue has already exceeded annual budget and with five months left in the year. Whatley made a motion to accept the financials as presented. Councilmember McClurkin seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Councilmember Robins reported the painting company has started on the entrance signs and should be finished by the end of the week.

Bell-Guercio reported that due to the Covid-19, the 4th of July celebration will be cancelled this year. Also, due to minimum governance the last few months, we will not publish *The Village Voice* for the second quarter.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:20 pm.
