**Minutes of the Town of Indian Springs Village Council Meeting
May 21, 2024**

The Town Council of Indian Springs Village met at the Town Hall at 2635 Cahaba Valley Road on Tuesday, May 21, 7:00 p.m., in a regular meeting. Mayor Brenda Bell-Guercio presided.

Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and initiated the proceedings with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Emmett Chambliss of Troop 533.

Councilmember Herb Robins stated he had received a final invoice proposal from Convergent Technologies which was for security equipment installed [no labor] with the understanding that payment would be final and the contact and services terminated. Robins explained that after 7 months on an estimated one week project, Convergent Technologies had failed to perform and did not meet the goals of the project as promised. Councilman Harley made a motion to pay the invoice and terminate Convergent Technologies. Councilmember Robins seconded and with all in favor, the motion passed.
