

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
November 17, 2020

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, November 17, 2020. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All Councilmembers were present except Ed Whatley.

The minutes of November 3, 2020 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember Harley seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Wayne Jones reported that the ZBA is waiting for some additional information from Starbucks Architects. When information is received a ZBA meeting will be scheduled.

The Council discussed the volunteers Christmas party. Due to Covid, the party will be cancelled this year.

Bell-Guercio suggested the nuisance ordinance be put on hold until 2021.

Harley presented the October financials. He made a motion to accept as presented. Elliott seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Harley also presented details on his work on purchasing new signs. He will get quotes from a new sign provider and also meet with County Engineers and get back to the Council with an update. Harley also presented his review of the Town's fee schedule. His work will be revisited at a later date.

Robins reported the new AED was installed in the new building as the last project of Chief Tyler before his retirement. Thanks again Chief for all you did for our Town.

The Council reported positive feedback so far on implementing a proposed sales tax.

The Town Hall hardwood floor project was discussed. More quotes will be obtained before a decision will be made.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:50 pm.
