

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
October 20, 2020

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, October 20, 2020. Mayor Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All Councilmembers were present except Ed Whatley and Dale Elliott.

The minutes of October 6, 2020 were reviewed. Councilmember Harley made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Councilmember McClurkin seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio recognized Wayne Barber of DeLoach, Barber & Caspers, P.C. Mr. Barber presented the audit for the year end 2019. Barber noted that ISV had an increase in net change in position of \$115,940. Once again Barber reiterated the Town has no debt and is in a very strong and sound financial position. Harley made a motion to accept the audit as presented. McClurkin seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio asked the council to consider joining the Shelby County Chamber of Commerce. Harley made a motion that ISV join the SCCC. Robins seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Bell-Guercio reported she has been working on her article for *The Village Voice* which will be published in November. She advised the Council that the article discusses the benefits of a sales tax for our town.

Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 8:05 pm.
