

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

October 4, 2022

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, October 4, 2022. Chairman Pro Tem Herb Robins called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The clerk called the roll and Mayor Bell-Guercio, was not in attendance.

Minutes of September 20, 2022 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember Hurley seconded and the vote was unanimous

Councilmember Hurley presented the August 2022 financials. The financials were discussed and Elliott made a motion to accept the financials as presented. Whatley seconded and the vote was unanimous. The August 2022 financials stand approved.

Ordinance 2022-004, an ordinance concerning an increase in Municipal Business License Issuance Fees was presented by Chairman Pro Tem Robins. Robins asked for a motion unanimous consent for immediate consideration of Ordinance No. 2022-004. Elliott made a motion for immediate consideration. The roll call vote was as follows:

Robins presented the new SRO contract and discussed the new and final figures as there was an increase from last year. The contract had been introduced in previous meeting but the final figures were not available at that time. After discussion of contract, Councilmember Whatley made a motion to approve the new SRO Grant of \$42,858 with Safe School Initiative, Elliott seconded, and the vote was unanimous.

Robins asked for a motion to continue the public hearing on 5542 Timber Hill Road to allow

more time for repair work to be completed. Councilmember Harley made a motion to continue the public hearing until the November 1, 2022, council meeting. Councilmember McClurkin seconded and the vote was unanimous. Robins discussed a complaint he had received on property located on Marivale Lane. The property was investigated by the ISV Building Inspector and a letter was sent to town attorney Goldman for review.

Robins reminded everyone about the upcoming Indian Springs Village Founders Day Celebration on 10-18-2022.

Robins adjourned the meeting at 7:30 p.m.
