

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
September 18, 2018

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, September 18, 2018. Chairman Pro Tem Herb Robins called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and the Boy Scouts in attendance led the Pledge of Allegiance. All Councilmembers were present except Mayor Bell-Guercio and Councilmember Whatley.

Minutes from September 4th, 2018 were reviewed. Councilmember McClurkin made a motion to accept the minutes as presented and Councilmember Elliott seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the minutes stand approved.

Chief Tyler reported that the new breast cancer shirts are now on sale at the Valleydale station for \$10. Sizes range from Medium – 2X. The last two weekends were spent in Homestead installing approximately 100 free fire detectors and will continue this weekend. The American Red Cross has partnered with the NSCFD to proactively address fire risk. Tyler also reported October they will start fire hydrant flushing.

Councilmember Elliott reported that the ISV chapter of the Kiwanis Club is still in the process of raising funds to purchase Chrome Books for students at OMHS, OMES, OMMS and OMIS to use for those who could not afford them. Application for grants are underway, along with setting up accounts for contributions that will be tax exempt. There will be an article on the fund-raising project in the next *The Village Voice*.

Elliott reported that Rep. Arnold Mooney has presented a draft of a bill that he will sponsor which will outlaw the sale of products that defeat drug testing.

Elliott also reported that working with Compact 20/20 there are now 14 members on the medical advisory panel that will be working to overcome the opioid crisis threatening our community.

Robins presented the proposed ISV 2019 budget. The budget was discussed at the August 7<sup>th</sup> council meeting. Elliott made a motion to accept the budget as presented. McClurkin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Robins also presented Resolution 09-18-18-01 that approves the ABC application for restaurant retail liquor as applicable to Donmar Restaurants LLC d/b/a Cajun Boys and Our Po Boys located at 2673 Valleydale Road, ISV, AL. Elliott made a motion to accept the resolution as presented and Stauss seconded, the vote was unanimous.

Robins read the proclamation that proclaims September 24, 2018 as Family Day and the week of September 23 through September 29, 2018 as Family week in the Town of Indian Springs.

The clerk reminded everyone Founder's Day is the third Tuesday in October at 6:30 catered by Texas Road House. Also, we are trying to see if there is interest in a Trunk or Trick. We

discussed the possibility of partnering with the ISV Baptist Church to avoid competition and increase the size of the event.

Robins adjourned the meeting at 7:40 P.M.
