

INDIAN SPRINGS VILLAGE
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
September 3, 2019

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Tuesday, September 3, 2019. Mayor Brenda Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance. All councilmembers were in attendance except Councilmember McClurkin.

The minutes from the Special Call Meeting of August 6, 2019 were reviewed. Councilmember Elliott made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilmember Stauss seconded and the vote was unanimous.

Wayne Jones, PAZ Chairman, reported a new sub-division request by Robins & Frederick will be heard September 10, 2019. The purpose of the subdivision is to reconfigure the property line between the parcels.

Chief Tyler, NSCFD, reminded everyone of National Night Out being held October 1st from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at Heardmont Park. He also reported 202 calls for the month of August which is a record for the most calls in a month.

Boy Scout, Austin Lee, was recognized for being in attendance at the Town Council meeting. Austin is working on his Eagle badge and was here to qualify for his public speaking badge.

Councilmember Whatley reviewed the June and July financial reports. He made a motion to accept financials as presented and it was seconded by Elliott. The vote was unanimous.

Whatley also presented the proposed budget for 2020. An additional line item will be placed into the budget for the gas & diesel tax monies that will be received in the next physical year. The council will vote on the budget at the September 10th Council Meeting.

Councilmember Robins reported on the exterior renovation. The parking pad was completed, the gutters will go on next week. More rock has been ordered to complete the pump house. The project should be wrapped up within the next two weeks. He also noted he will be in touch with a landscaping company to give us a price on new landscaping around the building.

The Mayor recognized Phillip Dean. Mr. Dean and several interested parties from OMMS were in attendance to ask the Council to consider a grant for repair to the baseball and softball fields. The Council will look into the legalities of a grant and will get back in touch with them.

Mayor Bell-Guercio adjourned the meeting at 7:58.
