August 27, 2020

The Indian Springs Village Town Council met Thursday August 27, 2020. Mayor Brenda Bell-Guercio called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. All councilmembers were in attendance except Councilmember McClurkin.

The special meeting was called to discuss and approve a Transportation Plan FY 2021 as required by the Rebuild Alabama Act.

Mayor Bell-Guercio presented resolution no. 08-27-20-01 for consideration by the Council.

Whatley made a motion to accept resolution no. 08-27-20-01 as presented below:

RESOLUTION NO. 08-27-20-01

WHEREAS, ACT Number 2019-2, known as the Rebuild Alabama Act, was approved by the Alabama legislature to levy excise taxes on gasoline and diesel fuel and

WHEREAS, Act Number 2019-2 provides for the distribution of a portion of these revenues to local governments for the construction, maintenance and repair of public roads, highways and bridges, and

WHEREA, the legislation requires the development, approval and dissemination of an annual transportation plan by the governing body of the municipality, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED By the Town Council of the Town of Indian Springs Village, Alabama that the Town of Indian Springs Village Plan for fiscal year 2021 be approved as presented and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk be directed to give proper notice of the approved Transportation Plan as required by Act Number 2019-2.

FY 2021 Town of Indian Springs Village Transportation Plan

Under the Rebuild Alabama Act, the Town of Indian Springs Village adopts this Transportation Plan that will be updated annually to list projects for which expenditures are intended to be made in the next fiscal year for any of the following uses allowed that are the responsibility of the Town.

1. The maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of roads and bridges
2. Matching funds for federal road or bridge projects;
3. Debt repayment for road and bridge projects; or
4. Joint road and bridge projects with one or more municipalities and/or counties.

At this time, there are no known projects FY 2021.
